Sestriere and the mountains of Piedmont host the 2025 edition of the Audi Fis Ski World Cup

The Alpine Skiing World Cup will stage in Sestriere, Friday 21st, Saturday 22nd and Sunday 23rd February 2025. Following the success of the previous editions, the mountains of Piedmont and the slopes of the Vialattea international ski area reclaim their role as stars of the Ski Circuit.

Once again, the programme will include three women's races, starting with the giant slalom followed, on the second day, by the slalom.

"We are proud to welcome a new edition of the Alpine Ski World Cup to Sestriere, on the slopes of the Vialattea" – says Gualtiero Brasso, Chairman of the Sestriere Organising Committee – "and we would like to thank the President of the Piedmont Region, Alberto Cirio, and his Councillors for the invaluable support they have shown us right from the start. It will give us all a special opportunity to show what the host region can offer at international level, not only in terms of sport, but in terms of tourism in general. Our main aim in fact is to promote the area and convey the best image of Piedmont and its mountains all over the world."

Several fringe events will set the scene for the Audi Fis Ski World Cup to give the skiers the warmest possible welcome and involve as many mountain and winter sports enthusiasts as it can. It will be a beautiful weekend of festivity and joy in the Vialattea ski resort, starting from Friday 21, as we have accepted the request from the FIS to recover in Sestriere the Giant event cancelled in Canada. We will therefore have three World Cup races: two Giant Slaloms, on Friday and Saturday, and the Special on Sunday.'

The world's finest skiers will be competing against each other on the slopes that have hosted the greatest sporting events, the legendary Kandahar Giovanni Alberto Agnelli, a spectacular slope capable of glorifying competitive feats and delivering powerful emotions.

A grandstand with over 750 seats will be set up near the finishing line, along with a hospitality tent for accredited guests and a Snow Village featuring a variety of stands to entertain the public before and after the races: a real open-air showcase where the products of prestigious partner companies of the event will be on display. The streets of Sestriere will also be brought to life by cheerful structures set up especially for the two days of competition.

The town's main square, Piazza Fraiteve, will be the focal point on Saturday afternoon, hosting the medal ceremony for the first race, the giant slalom, and the presentation of the skiers competing in the second race, the slalom: a unique opportunity to see the champions up close and watch the spectacular Laser Show, a dynamic and festive performance that will accompany the skiers on stage with stunning light and colour effects.

One of the brand new highlights of the 2025 edition which is not to be missed is the performance by internationally acclaimed electric violinist Andrea Casta. His famous luminous bow and adrenaline-filled performances bring the energy of music and sport together in a moment of magic.

Sestriere and the Vialattea slopes await you to experience two days of sport and excitement together!

































2022 edition - last leg of the World Cup on the slopes of Sestriere

The last appointment with the World Cup races in Sestriere dates back to **10/11 December 2022**. Two women's races were staged on that occasion too, a giant slalom won by a splendid Marta Bassino, who succeeded in delivering her best performance on the Olympic slopes of her home region of Piedmont, and a slalom won by Swiss skier Wendy Holdener.

Spectators - Over 25,000 people came to Sestriere to watch the races. The entire weekend was a succession of exhibitions, meetings, tastings, music and various kinds of entertainment involving the whole village to welcome the skiers, fans and tourists in the warmest and most cheerful way possible.

Audience Report - The return generated by the event on television emerges clearly from the official report of Infront, owner of the television rights to the World Cup competitions. The Audience Report shows that the races of 10/11 December 2022 totalled around 65 million viewers in the 22 countries that broadcast the event, exceeding 340 hours of airtime.

Historical significance of the event

Sestriere represents a traditional leg on the Ski Circuit. In fact, it's one of the ski resorts that has hosted the largest number of World Cup competitions. Right from the first season of this prestigious competition circuit, Sestriere had the honour of hosting one of the first legs, way back on 3 March 1967. On that occasion, Frenchman Jean Claude Killy won the men's downhill on the legendary Kandahar Banchetta slope while, in the women's competition, Giustina Demetz and Marielle Goitschel tied for first place, sharing the top step of the podium. Of course, we mustn't forget that, even before the birth of the World Cup circuit, Sestriere was also home to the legendary Arlberg-Kandahar international competitions, organised since the early 1950s.

During its long competitive history, Sestriere has organised 67 World Cup races (30 men's and 37 women's), not counting the '97 World Championships and the 2006 Turin Olympics. The greatest champions of world skiing have been crowned there: memorable and, above all, unique were the exploits of Alberto Tomba, winner on the slopes of Sestriere six times and undisputed protagonist at the competition venue from 1987 to 1994. The double in the giant slalom and slalom in the 1987 World Cup edition was magnificent, with these first two victories marking the start of the Bolognese champion's brilliant career.

Sestriere also holds the record for having organised the first World Cup nocturnal slalom in 1994, won in this historic edition by Alberto Tomba.

Our partners, the strength of the organising committee

A key role in the organisation of the event is played by the partners. In addition to the numerous sponsors and commercial partners, the great involvement of all the main institutions operating in the area and believing in its potential, from Piedmont Region to the Municipality of Sestriere, from the Sestriere Tourism Consortium to Turismo Torino e Provincia, should be highlighted. All united by a very ambitious common goal: to organise the event in the best possible way in order to show the world an area of outstanding tourist value.

The ski schools in the area are also making their professionalism available by working directly along the competition slope, and the same goes for Grigata Alpina Taurinese, which, as always, supports the work of the Committee with professional staff and equipment. The doctors and nurses of ASLTO3, experts in emergency - urgency management, are involved too, providing the skiers and the spectators expected to attend the competitions with direct and qualified assistance. The collaboration with Arpa Piemonte has been renewed and will provide a weather service dedicated specifically to the event, in support of the organising committee.

































The Kandahar Giovanni Alberto Agnelli slope

The races will take place on the Kandahar Giovanni Alberto Agnelli slope in Sestriere, famous for hosting great sporting events and for launching so many great champions into the Olympus of world skiing. It has been the scene of countless World Cup races, technical disciplines and the men's and women's slalom races of the 1997 World Ski Championships and the XX Winter Olympic Games, held in Turin in 2006.

Occupying a very central position, with the finish line located in town itself, the Kandahar Giovanni Alberto Agnelli slope is served by the Cit Roc lift, a new six-seater lift opened to coincide with the last edition of the World Cup held in Sestriere in December 2022.

The giant slalom starts on the slopes of Monte Sises, at an altitude of 2,400 metres, and the starting gate is reached by taking the Sises ski lift from the top station of the Cit Roc lift. The descent begins with a steep wall, then crosses a slightly gentler section of slope near the Alpette area leading to the start of the slalom. Here the course becomes challenging again, with a succession of very technical passages. The final stretch is much easier and smoother and leads to the spacious area which hosts the finish line and offers a perfect view of the competition slope.

The Kandahar Giovanni Alberto Agnelli was also the first slope to host a World Cup race at night at international level, in December 1994.

This historic slope, originally named the Kandahar Slalom, was named after Giovanni Alberto Agnelli, who died only a few months after serving as Chairman of the Committee for the Organisation of the 1997 World Ski Championships, in 1998.

It is a fantastic slope for great sporting events, but also an exciting and highly entertaining run for tourists who choose the Vialattea international ski area.
