AUDI FIS SKI WORLD CUP SESTRIERE KANDAHAR SLOPE PASSES SNOW CHECK

SESTRIERE - This morning, Thursday 13th February, in the week before the Audi Fis Ski World Cup Sestriere, the FIS officials went up to Sestriere for the ritual snow check. The Kandahar Giovanni Alberto Agnelli slope passed the check thanks to the fundamental contribution of the new Vialattea snowmaking system and the recent snowfall, as well as the great work done by the grooming staff.

Green light is given to the 'water injection' phase of the race course, a necessary operation that involves injections of water into the snow with the final objective of obtaining a homogeneous base at every point of the course in order to offer each athlete an optimal slope with the same characteristics for all competitors in the race.

The appointment with the Alpine Skiing World Cup in Sestriere is confirmed from Friday 21st to Sunday 23rd February.
